Greek Combining Forms

- These forms, sometimes called roots, compound to form words such as *photograph*, *microscope*, and *psychology*.
- Some of the combining forms such as *tele* & *auto* act as prefixes.
- Some of the combining forms such as *ology* & *logue* act as suffixes.

hydro – water	ology - study
bio – life	geo - earth
biblio – book	astro - star
auto – self	psych - mind
chrom – color	chron - time
