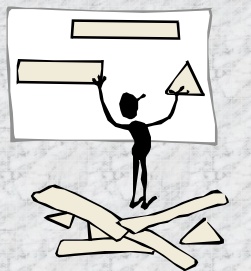

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The function of student behavior

- Describe the undesired behavior (form, frequency, duration, and intensity)
- Predict the times and situations when the undesired behavior will and will not occur
- Define the functions that the undesirable behaviors produce for the individual
- Interview the person and those who know him/her best to determine the goal of the misbehavior
- Do a direct observation over an extended period of time.



The function of student behavior

- Try to systematically manipulate the misbehavior
- Try and replace the misbehavior with a behavior that is more appropriate.
- Begin a behavior support plan.
- Behavior Goal of the student What the student is trying to avoid?
- Antecedents Behavior Consequence
