

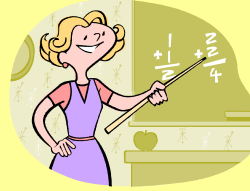

## Anita Archer's Essential Elements of Effective Instruction



- ☞ Maximize teaching time
- ☞ Teach to an objective
- ☞ Teach generalization strategies
- ☞ Present information clearly
- ☞ Select clear examples
- ☞ Actively engage students
- ☞ Maintain a perky pace

## More Tips for Teachers

- ☞ Carefully monitor student responses
- ☞ Correct errors in an appropriate manner
- ☞ Ensure high level of student success
- ☞ Continually assess student growth
- ☞ Rejoice in student achievement



## Student Achievement



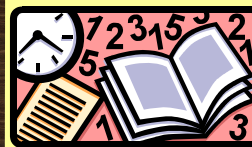
- ☞ Start lessons immediately
- ☞ Use a positive intervention plan
- ☞ Use clear class rules and expectations
- ☞ Use positive messages and a clear reward structure
- ☞ Be aware of antecedent triggers
- ☞ Be aware of goals of misbehaviors
- ☞ Implement logical consequences

## Effective teachers:

- ☞ Adapt pace, environment, materials and instruction
- ☞ Assess frequently
- ☞ Honor cultural and ethnic diversity and learning styles
- ☞ Use advance organizers to activate prior knowledge at the start of a lesson
- ☞ Move around the room during teaching



## Effective teaching practices



- ☞ Vary presentation style
- ☞ Use questions and student first names throughout lesson
- ☞ Vary grouping structures
- ☞ Actively involve students
- ☞ Have fun!
